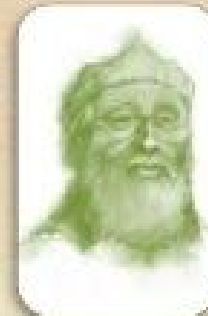
**Josiah

- Jerusalem is destroyed.



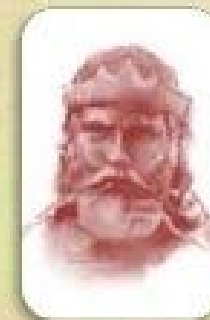
**Jehoahaz
